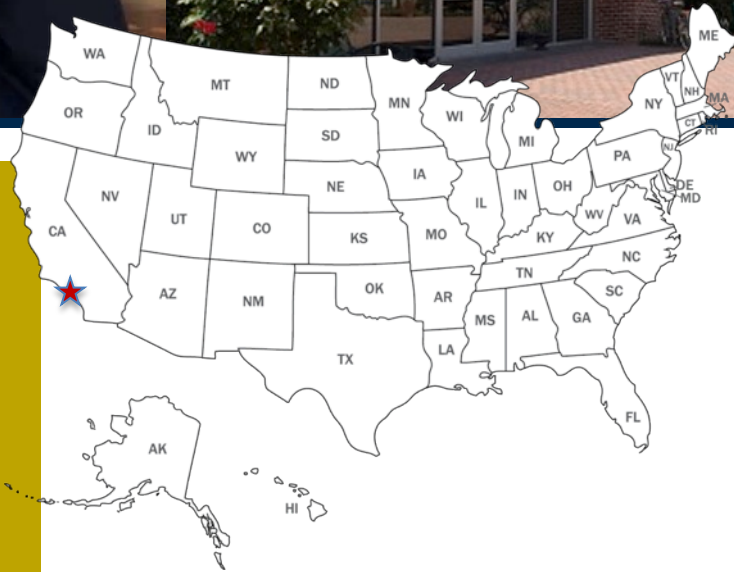


Heritage Christian School
