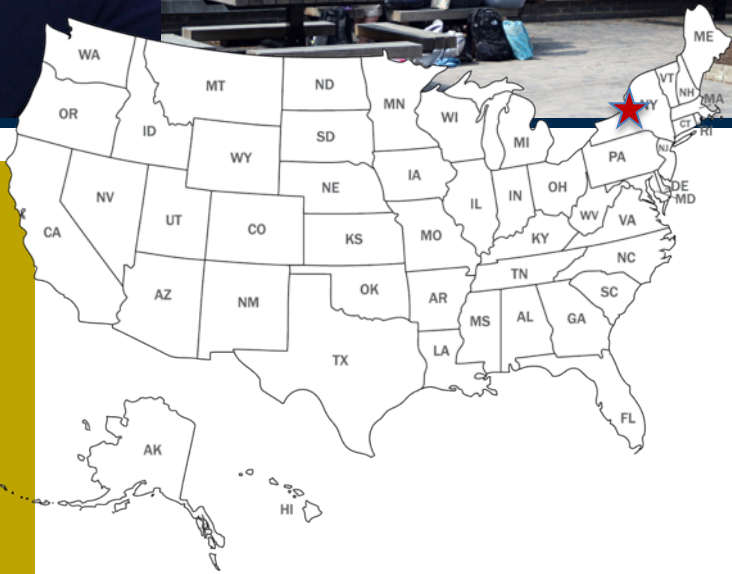


# Allendale Columbia School
